



FRIENDS OF THE UKRAINIAN FOLKLORE CENTRE STUDENT AWARD INFORMATION

Purpose: To fulfill the mandate of the Friends of the Ukrainian Folklore Centre (FUFC) to facilitate the growth of Ukrainian ethnology, which is the discovery of knowledge about Ukrainian culture and identity through the study of arts, customs, beliefs, songs, crafts, and other traditions.

This award will provide valuable financial assistance to undergraduate university students to pursue post-secondary education in Ukrainian folklore and will also enhance the awareness of Ukrainian folklore within the community.

Value: \$250 (maximum of 24 annually)

Conditions & Eligibility Criteria: Awarded to undergraduate students enrolled in Ukrainian Folklore courses within the Ukrainian Folklore Program at the University of Alberta. Scholarships will be awarded based on performance (academic standing). This award will be issued at the completion of each term.

To be considered, applicants must submit the attached application form by the end of the term in which they are currently registered in a Ukrainian Folklore class. A maximum of 12 awards will be issued every six months.

Awardees cannot receive the Friends of the Ukrainian Folklore Centre Student Award in conjunction with any other FUFC award. For UKR 327, students receiving tuition funding from the Friends of the Ukrainian Village Society or the Ukrainian Cultural Heritage Village are not eligible to apply for this award.

Selection Process & Award Receipt: The FUFC Award Committee, consisting of members of the board of directors of the Friends of the Ukrainian Folklore Centre (FUFC), will review all applications and choose the successful scholarship recipients based on academic performance and the conditions and criteria outlined above.

Payment Process: Award is to be used to offset tuition fees. The recipients will receive notification and payment at the end of the selection process, approximately six-weeks after the application deadline.

Application Procedures: Students must submit this application form by the deadline to be eligible. The application deadline for the fall semester is November 1 at 4:00 pm. The application deadline for the winter semester is March 1 at 4:00 pm. The application deadline for the spring semester is May 30 at 4:00 pm.
